Detailed Narrative Description of Project: The study involves the conduct of traffic count and socio-economic impact surveys of selected road projects in the Philippines. Such road projects include those which have been implemented with financial assistance from the Overseas Economic Cooperation Fund (OECF), and whose feasibility studies were undertaken by JICA. The objective of the surveys is to provide technical inputs to the Evaluation Study of the selected road projects, jointly organized and conducted by JICA and OECF. The study aims to formulate recommendations that would assist JICA and OECF to further improve the process of project planning, implementation and management of future road projects in the Philippines.		
Detailed Description of Actual Services Provided: The Consultant's scope of work include the following: 1. Conduct of traffic count surveys at eighteen (18) strategic locations (stations) along the project roads. 2. Conduct of socio-economic impact surveys at fifteen (15) sites, with a total target number of 350 respondents. 3. Compilation of data and information, including calculation of AADT and analysis of socio-economic impacts, based on the survey results.
